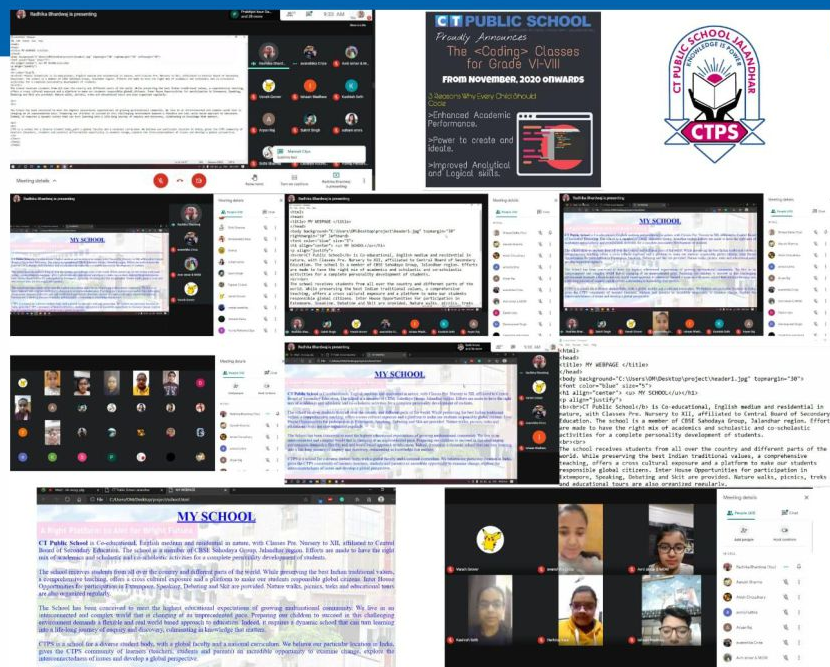
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CODING CLASSES

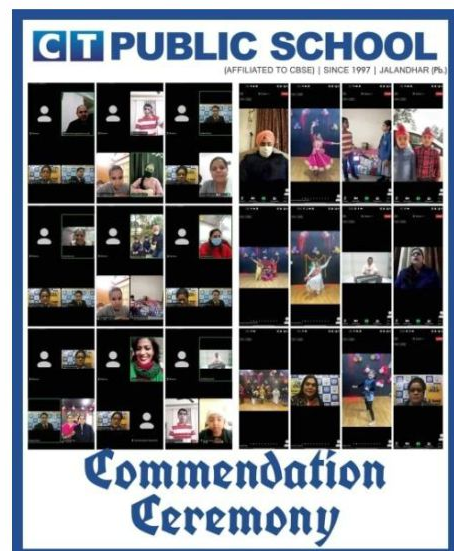

The resource person, Mr. Major Singh told that IELTS is a crucial examination for those willing to study abroad, especially in the US, UK, Canadian, Australian universities. Achieving an ideal score, that is, at least 7 as both overall band score and sectional band score in the exam is important for students to enhance their chances of getting admission in a foreign university of their own choice. But a small percentage of students manage to score above the 6.5 band score. This

implies that though scoring above 6.5 in the test is indeed a difficult task, but this session with students implied that with consistent and systematic preparations, it is possible for one to score high marks. Once they form a clear idea of the IELTS scoring mechanism, IELTS criteria for different universities, IELTS test patterns and the section-wise preparation tips and tricks, it will be easier for them to manoeuvre through this test and achieve a reasonable



score and can open doors to international academic and professional opportunities in many institutions and places in the world where English is used. It can help you reach your education, career or life goals. It provides great platform for study, work and immigration.
